The Representative's Council is a group of individuals that represent the Therapeutic Musicians Organizations that are accredited by the National Standards Board of Therapeutic Musicians.

The Council Members:

- * Attend monthly Board Meetings of NSBTM
- * Read Monthly Meetings Minutes
- * Read any documents presented
- * Participate in discussions
- * Act as a liaison between the Board and the group they are representing, giving any information or feedback to the Board pertaining to their program
- * Work as a team member with their Board Member by entering into dialogue with each other between meetings.
- * May be asked to represent a Board member at a Meeting at which point the Council Member will have full voting privileges. The Board governs by consensus.
- * Head up Committees and Special Projects.
- * Use Skype and know how to navigate the system. Send your Skype name to the Chair. Call the Chair at the designated time of the Board Meeting.

The term of service for a Council Member is dependant of the respective program the member represents.
